OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:-Combined Eligibility List of Chief Engineer(C/M) of MoRT&H -reg.

Whereas, as per the advice of UPSC vide its letter dated 09.10.2018, the Common Eligibility List for promotion to the grade of Additional Director General was placed in public domain vide Ministry's circular dated 11.10.2018 inviting representations, if any, latest by 18.10.2018. After consideration of all the representations received in the matter, the Common Eligibility List published vide Ministry's Circular dated 11.10.2018 was treated as final, vide order dated 24.10.2018 and 22.11.2018 by adopting the principle of "Batch Seniority" subject to completion of qualifying criteria.

2. And whereas, the Common Eligibility List was submitted to UPSC for holding of meeting of DPC for promotion to the grade of Additional Director General. UPSC vide their letter dated 21.12.2018 advised this Ministry to consult DoP&T on the same. Accordingly, DoP&T was consulted in the matter.

3. And whereas, as per above, the following revised provisional combined eligibility list of Chief Engineers (Civil/Mechanical) for consideration of their names for promotion to the grade of Chief Engineer for the vacancy year 2018 was published on Ministry's website vide O.M dated 16.04.2019 :-
