Subject: Monthly Summary for the Cabinet for the month of November, 2021.

1. **Award and construction of National Highways:** The Ministry has constructed 5,118 K.M. of National Highways up to November in 2021-22 as compared to 6,207 K.M. up to November in 2020-21. The award figure is 5,578 K.M. during this period as compared to 6,764 K.M. in the previous year.
2. **Major changes in the MCA of TOT Model:** The Ministry has approved major changes in the Model Concession Agreement (MCA) of Toll Operate Transfer (TOT) subsequent to the concurrence of Inter- Ministerial Committee. Changes in the MCA of TOT allowing NHAI to undertake capacity augmentation in a particular section of the Project Highway and small improvement works have been made. Further, in case the concessionaire faces revenue loss due to capacity augmentation undertaken by NHAI, the same will be reimbursed to the concessionaire by the Authority in order to ensure proper valuation of ToT projects. Similarly, it has also been decided that in case of any increase or decrease in tollable length due to capacity augmentation, the concessionaire will either pay the money or receive the compensation so that the concessionaire enjoys a financial situation as if no such Capacity Augmentation had taken place.
3. **Modifications in the RFP documents:** The Ministry has approved modifications in the Request for Proposal (RFP) documents for engaging the consultancy works i.e. DPR, Authority Engineer (AE), Independent Engineer (IE) to make bidding documents compliant with Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017 and Rule 144(xi) of GFR.
4. **Extension in the date of applicability of CEV(IV) Emission Norms:** This Ministry, vide GSR 598(E) dated 30th September, 2020, had amended CMVR, 1989 to separate the emission norms for Agricultural machinery and Construction Equipment Vehicles (CEV) and notified that implementation of CEV-IV emission norms will come in to force from 1st April, 2021. It has also been provided that the vehicles manufactured with CEV-III norms shall be registered within six months from the date of manufacture. Ministry vide GSR 800(E) dated 15th November, 2021 has now decided to extend the period of registration by two months , i.e up to 30th Nov 2021.
5. **Loutolim to Verna Inaugurated in Goa:** Hon'ble Minister of Road Transport and Highways, Shri Nitin Gadkari inaugurated a four lane section from Loutolim village to Industrial Development Corporation, Verna on NH-566 at Verna, Goa on November 1,
