Sub:- Allocation of funds to the **States of West Bengal and Odisha** for incurring expenditure on the maintenance and repairs of National Highways under **Flood Damage Repair (New) [FDR (N)]** during the financial year 2020-21-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the placement of allocation of funds under **Flood Damage Repair (New) [FDR (N)]** as indicated in column (3) of enclosed Annexure to each States/UTs for incurring expenditure on the Maintenance and Repairs works of the National Highways under the jurisdiction of the States/UTs Governments during the Financial Year 2020-21.

2. The above expenditure is debit to the following head under Demand No.84-of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2020-21:-

- 3054 -Roads & Bridges (Major Head)
- 01 -National Highway (Sub - Major Head)
- 01.337 -Road Works (Minor Head)
- 01 -Maintenance by Roads Wing
- 01.02 -Maintenance by Roads Wing Financed from Central Road Infrastructure Fund
- 01.02.27 -Minor Works

3. The amount should be spent for the schemes sanctioned under the head indicated in para 2 only. No expenditure should be booked/incurred above the financial limit prescribed in each sanctioned job.

4. The ROs, Kolkata and Bhubneswar are allowed necessary temporary restoration works to be taken up by PWDs of the States of West Bengal and Odisha immediately to ensure immediate restoration of traffic movement in the sections of NHs damaged on account of cyclone 'Amphan'/floods, rainfalls, etc., within the funds allocated for this purpose. Officers posted in these ROs may undertake site visits and note down the specific works required to be taken up/being taken up in the damaged NHs stretches; these works may be regularized through sanctioning of FDR(N) estimates subsequently so that such works of immediate nature are not held up/delayed for want of sanctions at this stage.


